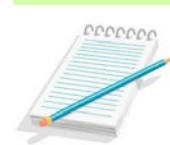

Mary, on the other hand, chose to sit at the Lord's feet and listen to His words. Clearly, Mary's choice is the most important because she is more concerned about each word that comes out of the mouth of our Lord. The meal that was to be served by Martha helps sustain our bodies. The words spoken by Christ, and the heavenly food, the Eucharist, that He gives us, sustains our soul.

Our missionary will be Father Ruffino Ezama. Father is a Ugandan Comboni Missionary who was ordained a priest in 1994. In 1996 he served in the parish of St. Francis of Assisi in the Archdiocese of Cotonou (in the Republic of Benin—a country which is about 24% Christian and over 60% belong to the traditional religion Voodoo). He worked in the pastoral activities of this large parish. In 2001 and 2002 Father Ruffino worked in Lodonga Basilica Parish (a Parish of about 90% Muslims) in the Arua Diocese Uganda as assistant pastor. He was the Provincial Vocation Promoter of the Comboni Missionaries in Uganda Province from 2004-2008. He is now a member of the North American Province doing mission education programs in their Provincial House in Cincinnati, OH.
