From the Pastor's Desk...



After 52 years, my family is moving out of the old family house on Hudson Street. This has necessitated moving countless boxes of old letters, toys, and even the very first pump organ on which I learned to play. It

certainly freshens the memory as I look over old military papers, bills, Christmas Cards, and antique furniture stored in the attic—all of which is a big part of the memory of growing up. These tangible objects have the same effect as memories; some make me laugh, some bring a forgotten moment into sharper focus and quite a few lead to a moment of prayer. For the three generations of papers and mementos, I'm thankful they still survived heavy-laden with dust and their ability to make me grateful to God for my family.

I know you hear creaking as you walk down the aisles of the church and you thought—this is an old building—check to see if I'm walking close by you—I turned 60 and the creaking of ancient bones can be frightening.

I would like to share an old-fashioned pot-luck with you on August 15th following the 11:00 Mass in the church undercroft.
